On Sept. 18 & 19, thousands of people came to celebrate the 40th annual Relief Sale in the Fraser Valley. In spite of recession woes, people came to eat, shop, visit and give, raising just over \$704,000.00 for MCC's "Food For All" projects.

Friday night was beautiful and warm, with rain arriving overnight. But it cleared up in time for the Cyclathon on Saturday morning. 32 cyclists rode either 20 or 40 kms. (or more), and raised almost \$55,000.00

Lots of good food was served and enjoyed, and shopping was brisk in crafts, garage sale, plants and produce. Children had great fun in the Kids' Area, including a Praise Concert and Puppet Show on Saturday morning.

The Silent Auction raised about \$10,000.00 on Friday night. Many lovely quilts and other articles were auctioned on Saturday. Of special interest was the loaf of bread, raising \$215,000.00 from multiple bidders. An oak seedling, that is a grandchild of the great Chortiza oak in the Ukraine, sold for \$14,000.00, and was then planted at the Reach Gallery Museum in Abbotsford. An RV was donated by Fraserway RV, which sold for \$18,500.00.

Many also donated generously at the donations booth, totalling \$118,000.00. Thanks to all who bought, donated, volunteered and served, including the Relief Sale Committee, and MCC and Tradex staff!

The Festival of Praise was held in the Emmanuel Church on Sunday, Sept. 21. We celebrated 40 years of Relief Sales, listened to great music by the Abb. Male Chorus, and heard a moving report of Wayne Bremner's visit to the Sudan. The congregation responded with an offering of over \$10,000.00.

We praise God for the generosity of all who contributed to the events of the Relief Sale weekend! Together, we have worked and served in the Name of Christ, and we pray that God will abundantly use and bless the money we have raised!
